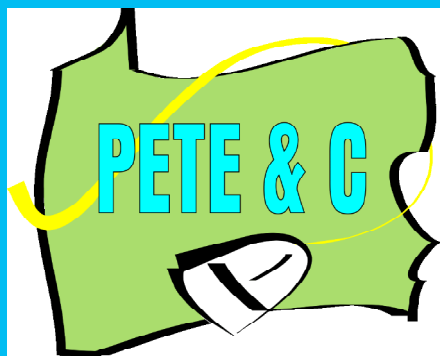

Pennsylvania Educational Technology Expo and Conference - PETE & C

The Details

The Invitation:

- Students in grades K-12 are invited to demonstrate the use of technology in projects they have created that support learning in Pennsylvania's classrooms. Individual students as well as teams of up to four students are eligible to apply.
- Students must be accompanied and supervised by a faculty advisor at all times during the conference.
- **Apply online** at www.peteandc.org November 4 to December 18, 2015. Click the Student Showcase Link
- Deadline to apply is Friday, December 18, 2015. Notification of acceptance will be sent by December 23, 2015.

The Student Showcase:

- Selected teams will display their projects from 9:45 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. **or** 12:30 p.m. - 2:45 p.m. on February 23rd during the conference. When teams receive their notice of acceptance, they will also be assigned a showcase time.
- PETE & C will supply each team with a three-foot table space and electrical connections. Please note: Wireless Internet connections will be available in the Student Showcase area.
- Schools must provide all computer and peripheral equipment. All equipment must fit within the assigned space. A description of the project creation process should be included with the display.

The Free Stuff:

- All students will receive a T-shirt, lunch, exhibit hall pass and other goodies. Faculty advisors will receive free conference registration on February 23rd and may attend that day's sessions. Faculty advisors will also be provided lunch and exhibit hall passes.

The Expense:

- A limited number of hotel rooms are available for schools traveling over 100 miles. These rooms will be paid for by PETE & C and are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
